- **Call to Order – President Inglis called the meeting to order.**

- **Council Item(s):**
 1. Raymond Bodnar Way – Manager Varhola explained the dedication and the motion to adopt Raymond Bodnar Way.

 2. Tax Anticipation Note – Manager Varhola discussed the TAN with Council. Councilman Ondo asked if it was necessary and Manager Varhola explained it carries the Borough from January until the Borough taxes start to come in. Councilman Ondo thought the bond monies could be used and Solicitor Evashavik advised it would be illegal.

 3. Transfers from Municipal Building Capital Fund – Manager Varhola explained the motion to transfer funds from the Capital account to the General Fund for items paid.

 4. Best of the Batch - Mr. Varhola explained Resolution 2020-7.

5. Hiring of Crossing Guard - Mr. Varhola explained the hiring of Mrs. Spears and went into the motion to run an ad for another guard. Councilman Ondo asked about the process that took place to hire her and Manager Varhola and President Inglis explained. Councilman Fallon asked about the current crossing guard shifts.

Mayor Brennan asked about the process set in place to authorize transfers from the Municipal Building Capital Fund account. Manager Varhola states Hatch Engineering makes suggestions to Council for approval.

Mayor Brennan and Council discussed the Zoom meetings and voiced his frustration with them. President Inglis agreed but it is what must take place during the pandemic. Solicitor Evashavik advised of the current restrictions.

Mayor Brennan asked a question about Ray Bodnar Way. He asked if it is an ordinance. Manager Varhola advised yes.

Councilman Fallon asked about some of the bills being paid. Manager Varhola explained. He then asked if there will be discussions about the 2021 budget. Manager Varhola advised not on this agenda but there is work to be done on it. He has presented it to Council for that work.

Mayor Brennan, Councilman Falce, President Inglis, Manager Varhola and Chief Pat Campbell discussed the crossing guards hiring process. President Inglis asked Mayor Brennan, Chief Campbell and Councilman Fallon to take the interview process.

President Inglis thanked Councilman Fallon for all the work taking down the banners on Main Street. Councilman Fallon said the Boy Scouts helped and were asking about taking care of the Veterans Monument on Longfellow Drive.

Councilman Falce informed Council of the ALOM banquet on December 3, 2020.

Councilman Petruzzi advised Council there are 3 new cases of COVID-19 within the Steel Valley School District.
